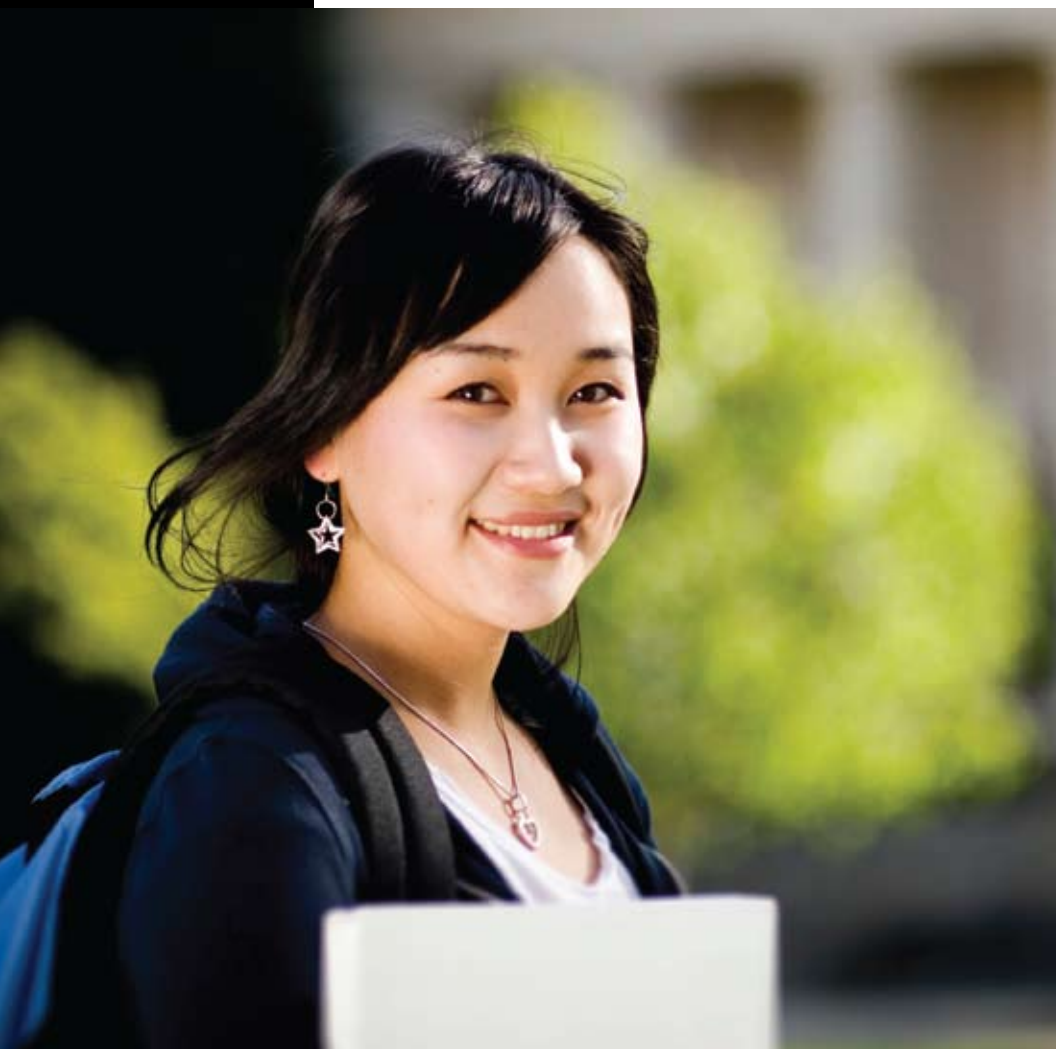

Phase One of the new Ambrose Campus is nearing completion. On September 8, 2008 a new chapter will begin when the doors will open to the first group of students.

The projected costs to build and move from our overcrowded downtown site are \$36 million. We have cash and revenue commitments (including possible sale of 4 acres) of \$21.95 million, and a planned mortgage of \$10 million. We still need to raise at least \$4.05 million.
