



Bachelor of Arts: History Concentration

The History Concentration provides students with a broad understanding of the human past. All students must study some Canadian, European, world, and pre-modern history as well as historiography—the study of the theory and practice of history. Other courses touch on subjects as diverse as the Middle East, early Christianity, European revolutions, Canada at war, the Holocaust, and depictions of history in Hollywood films.

General Requirements

- Completion of 90 credits

- Completion of degree requirements
- A minimum of 45 credits taken at the 200 level or higher
- A minimum of 3 credits taken in 6 different disciplines
- A maximum of 42 credits taken in any one discipline
- At least 72 credits in the Arts and Sciences
- A cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of at least 2.0 is required to graduate, with a GPA of 2.0 in all History courses.
