[Micalieah] As it is now, period products would cost 200\$ per month to be consistently stocked in the bathrooms.

The Students Council has decided to divert funds to placing free emergency menstrual products in the women's bathrooms in the upper and lower atrium. We will defer any action in the direction of a long-term solution to the incoming student council.
